RULE 60

Disputes

The amended passages are in bold.

The amendments to Rule 60 are in force as from 1st May 2012.

General	
1.	Unless as otherwise stated in Rule 60.2 or in any other Rule or Regulation, all disputes arising under these Rules shall be resolved in accordance with the provisions set out below.
2.	The following matters are excluded from the dispute provisions in this Rule 60:
	(a) any disputes arising out of decisions made under the Anti-Doping Rules in Chapter 3, including, without limitation, disputes arising out of a breach of the anti-doping rule violations. These disputes shall be resolved in accordance with the procedures set out in Rule 42;

(b) any breach of the Betting and Other Anti-Corruption Violations in Chapter 1 shall be resolved by the IAAF Ethical Commission in accordance with Rule 9 and the Code of

	Ethics;
	(c) any protests made prior to
3.	Each Member and Area Association shall incorporate
4.	Any athlete, athlete support personnel or other person:
	(a) who takes part
	(g) who takes part, or who attempts to take part, either directly or indirectly, in any betting, gambling or similar event or transaction connected with competitions in Athletics held under the rules of the IAAF, its Areas or Members;
	(j) who contravenes Rule 9 (Betting); or
