



Edition 141 - 29 March 2013 Looking ahead to... IAAF World Challenge

The 15 fixture series of the 2013 IAAF World Challenge gets underway in Melbourne, Australia, on Saturday 6 April, marking the start to the second most important tier of invitational track and field competition under the IAAF umbrella of permit meetings. This annual global series has meetings in all six IAAF continental Areas and offers five months of top class athletics which concludes in Rieti, Italy, on Sunday 8 September.

The IAAF World Challenge series straddles the pinnacle event of the IAAF Competition Programme, the 2013 IAAF World Championships, Moscow 2013 (10 to 18 August). A significant milestone on the road to those championships will take place next month when a meeting of the IAAF Council is held in the Royal Radisson Hotel, Moscow on Saturday 6 and Sunday 7 April, and will be followed on Monday 8 April by an IAAF Press Conference to promote Moscow 2013.


