Looking ahead to... World Athletics Gala

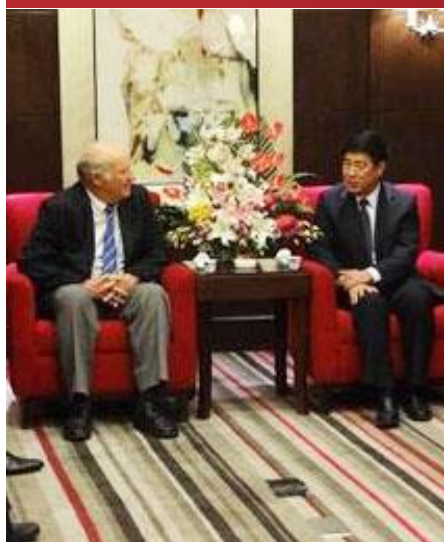
On Saturday 16 November 2013, the prestigious annual [World Athletics Gala](#) will be hosted in the Salle des Etoiles at the Sporting Monte-Carlo by International Athletic Foundation (IAF) Honorary President HSH Prince Albert II of Monaco and IAF & IAAF President Lamine Diack.

The highlight of the evening will of course be the announcement of the **2013 Male and Female World Athletes of the Year**, with the winners being presented with their trophies live on stage. A panel of experts drawn from the six Areas of the IAAF has selected 10 men and 10 women as the [World Athlete of the Year Nominees](#) for 2013.

The Gala which will be attended by a glittering array of present and former champions will also give the global Athletics family the opportunity to honour other outstanding athletic achievements via further awards including the latest induction into the [IAAF Hall of Fame](#).

November also marks the beginning of the [2013/2014 IAAF Cross Country Permit](#) season which will kick off on Sunday 10 November in Soria, Spain.
